All swimmers and coaches are requested to follow the warm-up procedure in order to ensure a safe and high quality warm up for all participants.

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2. REGISTRATION PROCESS

2.1 ENTRY AND CLOSING DATE

Entries to the competition must be registered in IPC Online Entry System until **10 October 2021** <https://db.ipc-services.org/sdms/entries/index>

ENTRIES TO THE EVENTS SHOULD BE FILLED IN SPLASH MEET MANAGER WHICH WILL BE SEND TO THE TEAMS FEW WEEKS AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE.

2.2 FINAL ENTRY BOOKING FORM

In order to make your necessary accommodation booking, and ensure transport and accreditation for your team you must submit your Final Entry Booking Form by the Final Entry Deadline (**10 October 2021**) to the LOC on BOTH e-mails:

The Final Entry Booking Form must contain the following, fulfilled information for your team:

Please be informed, that applications sent after the deadline may not be accepted.

Please fill the Entry Form carefully and with full responsibility, no changes will be accepted after the deadline! Teams record their application in the LOC could be charged in case of changing or canceling their Entry after deadline!

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2.3 INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION

International Classification will be offered for the athletes with physical impairment on 02 - 04 November 2021* according to WPS Classification Rules and Regulations (January 2018). *-The LOC reserves right to change the starting date of classification depending on the number of the athletes that will require classification at this event. The first day of classification can change to 03 November. The confirmation will follow shortly after the entry deadline.

3. ENTRY PACKAGE

3.1 BASIC ENTRY FEE

The registration fee (the Basic Entry Fee) per each person (athletes & team officials) is 50 €. This cost includes:

- Daily transport shuttle (hotel-venue)
- Competition operation costs

Fees must be paid to the competition office upon arrival at the competition.

3.2 CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS POLICY

Cancellations until the Final Entry Deadline (10 October 2021)	Teams are not liable to pay the basic entry fee for any canceled participants
Cancellations between 11 October 2021 and 20 October 2021	Teams are not liable to pay the basic entry fee for any canceled participants
Cancellations from 21 October 2021	Teams are liable to pay 50% of the basic entry fee and 50% of accommodation costs for any of canceled participant (whole team costs in case of canceling participation of the team)

The outstanding fees due to cancellation must be paid to the LOC upon arrival at the competition. In case of canceling a participation of the whole team after 21 October 2021 (and therefore when there would be no possibility for the team to pay at the LOC office), the LOC will issue an invoice for the relevant to the team for payment via a bank transfer.

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4. ACCOMMODATION/MEALS

Please be informed, that the LOC is responsible for the whole reservation in Radisson Blu Hotel, a 4 stars hotel with adaptation for people with disabilities. This Hotel has been chosen because of an excellent standard and a high quality of service. Besides, the LOC cooperates with this hotel since 2006 and guarantees suitable accommodation during the competition. Radisson Blu Hotel is located in the center of Szczecin, nearby the shopping center and many city attractions. Radisson Blu Hotel is also located close to the venue which allows an easy transport for all teams.

Please note, that this hotel is the only official hotel for the competition and no other hotels are permitted to be used by competition participants.

The accommodation fee includes full board alimentation:

- Double room: **100 €** per person per day
- Single room: **120 €** per person per day

All accommodation fees must be paid directly to the LOC upon an arrival at the competition office, not to the hotel. The hotel will be in charge only to collect any necessary extra costs incurred during your stay (i.e. laundry, telephone, mini bar, etc.)

4.1 EARLIER ARRIVALS

In a normal conditions Radisson Blu Hotel has check-in for guests starting at 2 p.m.

In special cases we can try to welcome organized groups earlier than at 2 p.m. after consulting this matter with hotel's manager. Because of this fact, we kindly ask you to include this information in the notes of the Final Entry Form.

For the organization of accommodation for early arrivals and days outside of the Competition, please contact the LOC to make arrangements.

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4.2 WHEELCHAIR USERS

To improve arranging accommodation, we kindly ask national representations to fill with care the Final Entry Form with information about wheelchair users. This is a necessary information for booking suitable rooms in the Hotel. Please note that the number of adapted rooms is limited.

4.3 PARKING

This information concerns guests arriving with their own transport. Please be informed, that the LOC will not refund payments for parking at the hotel area. Charges should be paid at the Radisson Blu Hotel reception.

CAR – 55 PLN / day (approximately € 14/day)

BUS – 130 PLN / day (approximately € 32/day)

4.4 MEALS INFORMATION

The Accommodation Fee includes breakfast, lunch and an evening meal during the following period:

- the First Meal – due to the arrival time
- the Last Meal – due to the departure time

Teams will be provided with meals prepared respectively as much as it would be possible depending on their arrival/departure time.

5. TRANSPORT

5.1 TRANSPORT AT COMPETITION:

We pleasantly inform, that the LOC provides transportation adapted also for wheelchair users during the competition from the hotel to the venue (which is located two kilometers from the Radisson Blu Hotel). Buses will be operating according to the transportation schedule.

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5.2 TRANSPORT FROM AIRPORTS:

Please find below suggested airports to travel to the competition place:

Goleniów Airport – Poland

The nearest International Airport is Szczecin Airport (well known as Goleniów Airport - which is located 50 kilometers away from the City Centre of Szczecin).

Berlin-Schönefeld, Berlin-Tegel, Berlin Brandenburg Airports – Germany

Another choice is to take flight connection to Berlin Airport (Germany) - which is located 180 km away from Szczecin.

Transfers for the teams arriving to Berlin or other airports can be provided with additional cost as follows:

BUS/CAR SIZE	ONE-WAY (Szczecin-Berlin-Szczecin)	TWO-WAYS (2x Szczecin-Berlin-Szczecin)
8-people van	200 €	350 €
50-people bus	600 €	1100 €

The team must notify the LOC regarding their arrival and departure details by the final entry deadline (**10 October 2021**). Transfers cannot be guaranteed for information sent after this date.

6. COMPETITION DETAILS

6.1 TRAINING

A full training schedule for all arriving competitors will be prepared after the LOC receives all entries and will be distributed to all participating teams one week before the competition.

6.2 DOPING CONTROL

According to *The World Anti-Doping Code* doping control can be conducted during the competition. Polish Commission Against Doping in Sport will be overseeing the process and will be responsible for the sample collection.

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6.3 AWARDS

Individual events will be conducted as “point system multiple class events” (the final ranking according to the 2021 World Para Swimming Point Scores). Medals will be awarded only to athletes with World Para Swimming license and international classification.

Relay events will be conducted as “single class events” (the final ranking according to time). Medals will be awarded teams all teams (including both nationally and internationally classified athletes).

Medals in all the events will be awarded following the “minus one rule”.

6.4 WORLD PARA SWIMMING LICENSE

Only athletes with World Para Swimming license will be considered for World Para Swimming ranking and record lists.

6.5 CONDUCT OF COMPETITION

Winter Polish Open Championships in Para Swimming will be conducted according to the World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations valid at the time of the competition.

6.6 VISA
